 2. RFD - BASIC SECURITY - (ON ALL RFD CERTS) Reasonable measures shall be taken to maintain the safekeeping of all firearms and ammunition dealt with or kept in the course of the Registered Firearms Dealer's business.

Note

If a registered firearms dealer fails to comply with any of the conditions of registration specified in any part of this certificate the chief officer of police may remove his name and/or place of business from the register of firearms dealers. Without prejudice to removal from the register a dealer who fails to comply with any condition becomes liable on conviction to a period of imprisonment and/or a fine.

Registered firearms dealers are required to maintain their register for a period of five years.

Unless a new certificate is applied for and the appropriate fee paid prior to the expiry of this certificate, or within such time thereafter as the chief officer of police may allow, the name of the dealer will be removed from the register of firearms dealers.

Dealers are requested to report the loss of this certificate to their local police at once.
